Why people may choose to use drugs, how different substances affect us in different ways, how to minimise potential harm caused by drugs, and where to access information and support.

Alcohol and Other Drug Workshops


Who's it for?

You will learn why people use drugs, their effects, how to minimise any associated harms, when and how to start a conversation, and where to access information and support.

Responding to Challenging Behaviours

Who's it for?

Whether your organisation provides face-to-face services in a treatment setting or through broader community support, this workshop will provide the information and resources needed to engage with clients who are displaying challenging behaviours as a result of alcohol or other drug use.

Learning outcomes

You will learn about the relationship between mental health and substance use, and its effects on behaviour, and consider effective ways to respond to people who are distressed or agitated.

Alcohol, Other Drugs and Pregnancy

Who's it for?

This workshop is suitable for anybody interested in learning about the effects of alcohol and other drug use during pregnancy but is best suited to allied health workers or other individuals working with pregnant people or people planning a pregnancy.


Learning outcomes

Alcohol, Other Drugs and Mental Health

Who's it for?

This workshop is suitable for any workplace, association, or club looking to learn more about alcohol, other drugs and use.

Learning outcomes

Participants will learn about the relationship between substance use and mental health, increasing their understanding of mental ill health and how a person's overall level of well-being can affect their level of substance use, as well as how their substance use can in turn influence their mental health.


Learning outcomes

Who's it for?

This training package is considered to be professional development and is suitable for individuals working in client-facing roles across the community services sector.

Learning outcomes

This foundational course will introduce you to the methodology behind Brief Interventions, preparing participants to apply Brief Interventions in a range of settings, targeted to the stages of change.

Associated costs

For groups of fewer than 10 people (with a minimum of 4 participants per session) = **\$1,300** (GST Inclusive).

For groups over 10 people (maximum of 30 participants per session) = **\$1,500** (GST Inclusive).

Brief Intervention Masterclass

Who's it for?

This training package is considered to be professional development and is suitable for participants interested in building onto their foundational knowledge.

Learning outcomes

Apply Brief Intervention methodology to your personal workplace context with targeted approaches and intervention options.


You will leave this session ready to confidently undertake alcohol and other drug Brief Interventions in your workplace.
